<p><b>Clothing</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clothing you can be active in</li> <li>• Warm sweater/Sweatshirt</li> <li>• Bathing Suit (Please, no 2 piece or bare midriff)</li> <li>• Rain Jacket or Poncho</li> <li>• Nice outfit for Thursday Night Worship (optional)</li> </ul> <p><b>Footwear</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sneakers &amp; shoes that can get wet and stay on your feet (keens, crocs, water shoes, chacos, etc.), hiking boots (optional); no flip flops</li> </ul> <p><b>Other</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Towel</li> <li>• Toiletries</li> <li>• Sunscreen/Bug Spray</li> <li>• Sleeping Bag, Pillow, Twin Size Fitted Sheet</li> <li>• Small Daypack</li> <li>• Small flashlight or headlamp</li> <li>• Water Bottle</li> <li>• Fishing pole &amp; tackle to use during free time (optional.)</li> <li>• Bible/Notebook, pencil/pen, reading book</li> <li>• Digital or disposable camera (optional)</li> </ul>	<p><b>Clothing</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 3 pair of Hiking Socks (smart wool or wool: Not cotton!).</li> <li>• 5 pair Underwear</li> <li>• 3 T-Shirts (avoid cotton)</li> <li>• 1 Long-Sleeved Shirt: 1 (avoid cotton)</li> <li>• 1 pair of Pants (loose, light fabric or athletic, no jeans)</li> <li>• 1 pair of Shorts (loose, light fabric or athletic)</li> <li>• Wool or Fleece Jacket (avoid cotton)</li> <li>• Hooded Rain Jacket.</li> <li>• Swim Suit</li> <li>• 1 full set of clean clothes to wear upon return</li> </ul> <p><b>Footwear</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For Canoeing or Sailing Trips: 1 pair of shoes that can get wet &amp; will stay on your feet (chacos, keens, crocs, etc.) &amp; 1 pair of sneakers; no flip flops</li> <li>• For Backpacking Trips &amp; ADK Wild: 1 pair of hiking boots (broken in!) &amp; 1 pair of camp shoes (keens, chacos, crocs, sneakers, etc.); no flip flops</li> </ul> <p><b>Other</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sleeping Bag (mummy, synthetic, warm to 20 degrees.)</li> <li>• Bandana</li> <li>• Flashlight or headlamp (small, portable)</li> <li>• Water bottle</li> <li>• Towel/Shampoo/Soap (for shower upon return)</li> <li>• Pen/journal &amp; reading book</li> <li>• Toothbrush &amp; toothpaste</li> <li>• Sunglasses</li> <li>• Sunscreen/Bug Spray</li> <li>• Small bible</li> <li>• Ball cap</li> <li>• Wool/Fleece Hat</li> </ul> <p><b>Fowler provides the following gear:</b> Backpack, Sleeping pad, Mess kit, Tents and Other Group Gear</p>
