ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

Our gathering will begin with dinner and introductions on Monday evening, October 7. Fowler is situated approximately 2.5 hours from Albany International Airport. Our time together will end after worship on Thursday morning, October 10.

LODGING

Fowler offers 3 lodging opportunities that are limited on a first come basis.

Prayer Cabins (2) which are private cabins with a queen bed, bathroom, and sitting area.

Chi Rho House has (12) rooms with queen and twin beds, and private bathroom. This is the main lodge with Adirondack Great Room and break out spaces.

Pine Lodge provides bunk style sleeping with a shared bathroom
